"Holsters & the 170 Degree Rule". (part III)

This is Part III of a multi-part article on "Holsters and the 170 Degree Rule".

Straight hang holsters and the Dreaded 170 Degree Rule:

Straight hang holsters are given a break in the SASS rules. Shooters using straight hang holsters must be able to holster and re-holster their handgun. It's the same as picking up a vertically staged double barreled shotgun. However, the muzzle of the handgun MUST be pointing straight down or a 170 degree violation will be called.

Shooters using straight hang holsters can break the 170 degree point as often as those using a cross draw. When they turn to move and re-holster their handgun, they very often let the muzzle of the handgun get outside of the 170 degree point by not pointing the handgun straight down.

Both the shooter and the RO should pay particular attention to the muzzle of the handgun, its angle and when it gets started into the holster. Also remember what the rules say about being an RO, "Don't be a hard case". If you are the RO and see a shooter that is coming close to the 170 degree point, offer them some advice that will help them to get that muzzle started into the holster while they are still in the "Safety Zone".

DHI trusts that this series of articles has helped all our members to understand the proper meaning of the SASS 170 Degree Rule, and the possible application of penalties pertaining to a violation of that rule.

Remember, the 170 Degree Rule is not just for cross draw holsters, but for all main match holsters worn by participants in our sport.

That person contacted Johnny's daughter and arrangements were made to publish the book.

Gene was a shrewd businessman who could recognize an opportunity and took advantage of them, even when he couldn't afford it. His legacy is unmatched, with five (5) stars on the Hollywood walk of fame. Stage, Radio, Film, Recording, Television.

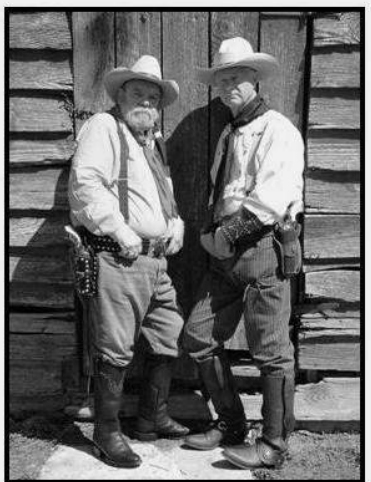
